PROFILE OF THE LITTLE WHITE CHURCH

This church had several affiliations with denominations since its inception in 1889. In 1988 we became a non-denominational church characterized by Elder rule. The congregation votes people to the positions of Deacon, Deaconess, Secretary, Treasurer, and Sunday School Superintendent. The Pastors and Elders are ordained by The Little White Church and affirmed by an annual vote of confidence of the congregation.

The congregation observes the ordinances of baptism and communion. Baptism of confessing believers is by immersion, although believers from other practices are accepted in membership by their signature of the Statement of Faith. Membership is based on (1) attendance, (2) the signature of a Statement of Faith and (3) a lifestyle not an offense to the Gospel.

If you would like to become a member of this fellowship, please request a Statement of Faith to sign. Persons filling leadership and teaching positions are required to be members.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

We believe:

- That the Bible was written by holy men as directed by the Holy Spirit and thus, it is the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
 - In one God, eternally existing in three persons: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
- ❖ In the deity of Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return to earth in power and glory.
- In a personal salvation through Jesus Christ by responding to Him in repentance, by verbally acknowledging Jesus is Lord, and believing in the heart that God has raised Him from the dead; and I confirm that I have personally received Jesus as my Lord and Savior.
- In the ministry of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer, whereby a Christian is enabled to live a godly and holy life in this present evil world; and I acknowledge his presence and control in my life.
- In water baptism as a command of Jesus Christ, Lord and Savior, to be experienced by everyone who believes in Him; and I admit to having been baptized.
- ❖ In the Lord's Supper, to keep it as instructed by the Lord Jesus; and by participation I confess to others my identification with Christ in His death.
